

The **Charles T. Aylesbury Scholarship** is a half tuition (\$18,000.00) scholarship presented to an LA Music Academy performance applicant. This prestigious award is granted to the applicant who is the most outstanding scholarship applicant. To be considered for this award the applicant must:

1. Exhibit exceptional abilities as a performer.
2. Best demonstrate his or her ambition to pursue a career in music.
3. Have maintained an excellent academic record.

Award	The full scholarship award is applied to tuition, after any federal or state grant funding, to obtain an Associate of Arts Degree in Music Performance. Renewal is automatic every quarter as long as the student achieves a cumulative grade point average of 3.50 for each quarters work and enrolls full-time. Room and board, books, and course materials are not included.
Eligible Applicants	Any incoming music performance student who will be starting in the spring or fall of 2010.
Eligibility Criteria	<p>Scholarship applicants must submit an LA Music Academy scholarship application (available for download), official high school/college transcripts, and two letters of recommendations and essay.</p> <p>Applicants must also submit a DVD demo that contains three musical selections. Chosen selections should be in contrasting styles that demonstrate musical strengths and versatility. Accompaniment is suggested.</p>
Deadline	Applications must be received no later than January 4th 2010
Acceptance	<p>Applicants must be an incoming LA Music Academy student. He or she has to be accepted and sign an enrollment agreement form.</p> <p>Scholarship recipients will be expected to represent the LA Music Academy College of Music in promoting music education at public and/or school-related events, as well as be a role model for other students.</p>
